


Tréguier's discovery trail





This back and forth botanical trail will guide you until the Tréguier's Belvedere, a beautiful point of view on the Sainte-Croix's Lake.



From Moustiers-Sainte-Marie's "Centre Historique" car parks, follow « Bélvédère de Tréguier » panels.


From this point, you will **walk back and forth**, following **20 educational panels** about local fauna and flora.

Throughout this **short family hike**, you will see Moustiers's restanques and olive groves (an important culture of the village). At the end of the trail, you will have to go up a rock to enjoy a beautiful view point: Sainte-Croix's lake on your right and Angouire's canyon.

A climb to the emblematic Notre-Dame de Beauvoir chapel and a loop through the olive groves: the perfect way to discover Moustiers-Sainte-Marie!



From Marcel Provence's street, walk up the 262 steps to Notre-Dame de Beauvoir's Chapel! Throughout the way is a beautiful view above the village and the Sainte-Croix's lake. Please note that the path to the Sainte-Madeleine cave is closed until further notice by municipal decree, you should go down by same way (all the steps)


Reach La Clappe's street, continue towards « Riou », its **old gate** and waterfall (it's dry now). End your trail on Les Claux's hill and its olive groves. First following "Claux Haut", then "Claux Bas".

You can reach back Moustiers's center and Frédéric Mistral street by the **chemin du Paradou**.



The Chain path





A short and demanding hike to reach the legendary Moustiers-Sainte-Marie star chain!

From the upper level of the village's "high car park", above the

cemetery, take the ascent to the Chemin de Courchon. Follow the

indications "Sentier de la Chaîne". The path is steep and rocky, but

few metres long (easy level). Follow the signs to "Pierrefeu".

⚠ It is not advisable to take the Ravin de Notre-Dame to reach the village, as there are regular rockfalls, and the path can only be used "at the hiker's own risk". ⚠

Return to Moustiers via the Courchon path, which offers a great panoramic view of the lake Sainte-Croix.
